We have recently taken possession of a piece of property located on Hwy 4 in Murphys that holds some historic significance. Until about 7 or 8 years ago it was the home of the former Murphys Nursery. However it has sat vacant for several years. But prior to that, and dating back to the 1860s, it was owned by well-known Murphys "dignitaries" such as James Sperry, original partner of the Sperry and Perry hotel, currently known as the Murphys Historic Hotel. Since the early 1900s the property was owned by the Williams family and it has since been known as the Williams Ranch. It originally contained hundreds of acres of land but is now down to less than 10. We will take great, great pride in our new stewardship of this historic ranch.

Over the course of the next few years we will focus our efforts on developing and protecting this last piece of the original ranch. We are super excited about our future with this property and with it comes an opportunity to plant a home vineyard for The Deviant. We also look forward to developing a Newsome Harlow wine tasting experience that is currently unrivaled in the Sierra Foothills region.

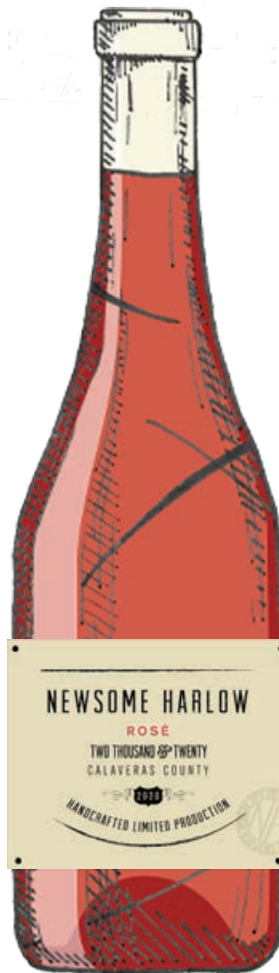

### 2020 SAUVIGNON BLANC

**Varietals:** 100% Sauvignon Blanc  
**Vineyards:** Jordan Oaks Vineyards, The Dalton Ranch, Aquinas Vineyard  
**Appellation:** Sierra Foothills  
**Aging/Cooperage:** 3 months in stainless steel  
**Alcohol:** 12.9%

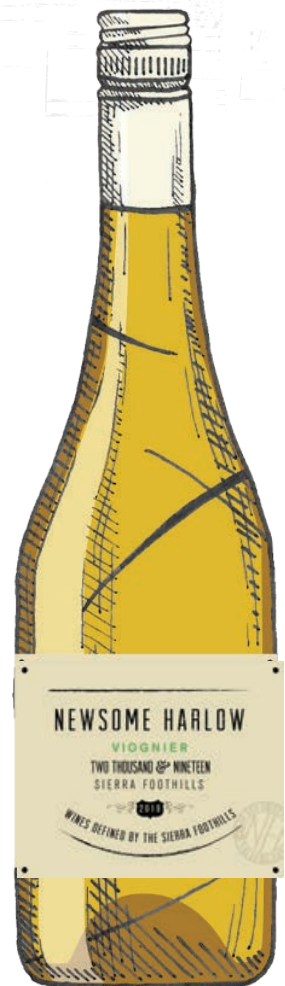
Crisp, clean, balanced. Pale straw in color, the first aromas in this new vintage are tropical melon, passionfruit & lemon. Secondary aromas are floral in nature with a bit of gooseberry and a touch of melon. At first taste, the wine hits you with high acidity and flavors of lemon, passionfruit, melon and a touch of grassiness. The acidity stays with you all the way through and the wine finishes with that same streak of melon and grapefruit.



### 2020 ROSÉ

**Varietals:** 100% Sangiovese  
**Vineyards:** Chatom Vineyard  
**Appellation:** Calaveras County  
**Aging/Cooperage:** 4 months in stainless steel  
**Alcohol:** 13.1%

Classic perfect pink in color, this very crisp Rosé starts out with classic aromas of watermelon, strawberry and cut hay. It also has developed some floral aromatics. Bright strawberries and more watermelon fill out the flavor profile. The wine boasts high acidity that leaves your mouth watering. It finishes crisp and long with prevailing watermelon notes.



### 2019 VIOGNIER

**Varietals:** 100% Viognier  
**Vineyards:** Lyman Vineyard & The Dalton Ranch  
**Appellation:** Sierra Foothills  
**Aging/Cooperage:** 18 months in neutral French oak barrels  
**Alcohol:** 14%

Golden yellow in color like hay, this wine kicks off with super intense aromas of stone fruits like apricot and peach. It also boasts tropical characters like banana, guava and pineapple. With great acidity up front in the mouth, the wine reveals bright lemon and apricot flavors with a hint of peach. The wine is medium-bodied and a little creamy as a result of the lees stirring. It finishes long and clean with the lemon and apricot characters riding into the sunset.
