
We have recently taken possession of a piece of property located on Hwy 4 in Murphys that holds some historic significance. Until about 7 or 8 years ago it was the home of the former Murphys Nursery. However it has sat vacant for several years. But prior to that, and dating back to the 1860s, it was owned by well-known Murphys "dignitaries" such as James Sperry, original partner of the Sperry and Perry hotel, currently known as the Murphys Historic Hotel. Since the early 1900s the property was owned by the Williams family and it has since been known as the Williams Ranch. It originally contained hundreds of acres of land but is now down to less than 10. We will take great, great pride in our new stewardship of this historic ranch.

Over the course of the next few years we will focus our efforts on developing and protecting this last piece of the original ranch. We are super excited about our future with this property and with it comes an opportunity to plant a home vineyard for The Deviant. We also look forward to developing a Newsome Harlow wine tasting experience that is currently unrivaled in the Sierra Foothills region.

2018 THE DEVIANT

Varietals: 50% Carignane, 17% Petite Sirah, 17%

Zinfandel. 16% Alicante Bouschet

Vineyards: 84% The Dalton Ranch, 16% Grant


Family Vineyard

Appellation: Calaveras County

Aging/Cooperage: 24 months in 3yr old French oak

Alcohol: 15%

Strong aromatics of boysenberry hit hard at first, a result of the Carignane which is the primary grape. Also some classic spicy aromas that blend really well with the touch of blueberry from the Petite Sirah. Strongest flavors are fresh plum, boysenberry and a touch of spicy oak with some cedar-like characters.



2018 ROLAND ROSARIO ZINFANDEL


Varietals: 96% Zinfandel, 4% Carignane Vineyards: 100% Roland Rosario Vineyard

Appellation: Calaveras County

Aging/Cooperage: 18 months in neutral oak

Alcohol: 15%

Intense raspberry fruit with jammy and spicy aromas. Flavors mirror the raspberries but with an addition of black cherry, anise and clove characters. This is a medium to full-bodied Zin with broad mouthfeel and spicy leathery characters. The tannins are structured and should preserve this wine for many years. Finishes long with darker fruit characters



2018 FOOTHILL ZINFANDEL


Varietals: 89% Zinfandel, 11% Petite Sirah Vineyards: Potter Vineyard, Roland Rosario

Vineyard & The Dalton Ranch **Appellation:** Sierra Foothills

Aging/Cooperage: 16 months in 20% new

American, 80% neutral **Alcohol:** 14.6%

Deep raspberry and plum aromas with some herbaceous characters combine with a slight chocolate aroma. The flavors mirror the raspberries and add a spicy component of nutmeg. This juicy Zinfandel finishes firm and fruity with lingering dark berry flavors and a peppery spiciness.




2019 DONNER PARTY ZINFANDEL

Varietals: 95% Zinfandel, 5% Petite Sirah Vineyards: 100% The Dalton Ranch Appellation: Calaveras County

Aging/Cooperage: 18 months in 20% new French

oak, 80% neutral oak **Alcohol:** 15%

Deep black fruit and spice aromas. The flavors are ultra-strong blackberries, anise and clove with an earthy component. This is one big Zin with broad mouthfeel and spicy leathery characters. The tannins are firm but structured. The wine finishes with long dark blackberry and plummy characters.




2019 BIG JOHN ZINFANDEL

Varietals: 100% Zinfandel (Deaver clone) Vineyards:100% Big John's Vineyard Appellation: Calaveras County

Aging/Cooperage: 18 months in 3yr old French oak

Alcohol: 14.6%

Strong raspberry and black cherry aromas combine with brambly flavors. Also juicy blackberry flavors and spicy tones. This classic Sierra Foothills style Zin finishes long & spicy with black pepper and lingering plum flavors.



2019 HERBERT VINEYARD ZINFANDEL

Varietals: 88% Zinfandel, 12% Petite Sirah Vineyards: 100% Frank Herbert Vineyard

Appellation: El Dorado County

Aging/Cooperage: 18 months in 2yr old French oak

Alcohol: 14.9%

Supple black fruits and spicy anise aromas combined with classic Sierra Foothill peppery Zin aromas and flavors. The mouthfeel has a focused supple character with a very slight perception of sweetness that heavily compliments the black fruit characters. The wine has a great mid-palate with classic foothill black pepper characteristics. Finishes soft but long with dark berries.
